

## **Inland Valley Symphony to Perform “Music with a View” Free Concert at Lake Elsinore Saturday, Sept. 1**

You are invited to bring a blanket, have a picnic, and listen to some fun music and great singers when Inland Valley Symphony performs at a free concert in McVicker Park, 7:30 pm, on Saturday, Sept. 1, 2007.

The concert will feature songs from Carmen, Man of La Mancha, My Fair Lady, Phantom of the Opera and Porgy and Bess, plus Academic Festival Overture by Brahms, Overture to Candide by Bernstein, Duke Ellington Medley and patriotic songs.

Well-known mezzo soprano, Janelle De Stefano, will sing Sequidilla and Habanera from Carmen, I Could have Danced All Night, Think of Me, Summertime and duets such as All I ask of You. Janelle has just returned from Spain where she performed as part of the Interpretation of Spanish Song Festival. She has been featured with Inland Valley Symphony several times in the past, as well as with San Diego Opera, Ash Lawn Opera Festival, La Jolla Symphony and Chorus, Opera Festival New Jersey and Grossmont Symphony. She was a member of the San Diego Opera Ensemble from 2002-2005.



Baritone Bryan Boos will be featured on Toreador Song from Carmen, The Street Where you Live, Get Me to the Church on Time, Phantom, Music of the Night and Bess, You Is My Woman Now and several duets. Bryan has also been featured with Inland Valley Symphony in the past, as well Los Angeles Music Center Opera, Opera Pacific of Orange County, the Long Beach Grand Opera and most recently in productions with the Old Town Temecula Theater Group. He was the bass soloist at the Crystal Cathedral and worked as a studio musician in both vocal and instrumental music in the Los Angeles area.

The program will conclude with Battle Hymn of the Republic, America, and Stars & Stripes Forever. Prior to the concert, a “petting zoo” for musical instruments will be offered to children who would like to see the instruments up close and ask the players questions about their instruments.
